

Love, Faith and Hope Lutheran Church was founded in April, 1996 in the home of founder, Rev. Dr. Felicia Campbell in Chicago, Illinois. There were approximately 3 people attending at that time where services were held in the basement of Dr. Campbell's home at 81st and Chappel. We grew by way of word of mouth and the weekly radio broadcast heard on WBGX. At that time, Pastor Campbell was on air at WHN radio daily with a musical program from 7am-2pm. A Daily Word gave title to For Your Consciousness Ministries, which later became the outreach of Love, Faith and Hope Church.

We outgrew 81st and Chappel and worshipped at Lutheran School of Theology on Saturdays at 12 noon. From there we purchased a church building from the Assemblies of God and paid for it in three years. We continued to grow in number but noticed that the community needed more than just church on Saturday. So we partnered with the Department of Human Services and launched a Women and Children's Shelter and a Single Women's shelter. Since then the church has incorporated other community programs under For Your Consciousness Ministries. These ministries include a food pantry, clothing pantry, soup kitchen, summer camp, after school programs, and many more.

Today, we are in full swing and claim the Englewood and New City Community as our Church.

Rev. Clay Evans installed us officially in the church in 1998. From that day we have moved full speed ahead. Many thanks to our founders who are with the Lord – Mom Lopez, Rev. Barbra, Mom Shirley, Kathy Farer, Rickey, Mom Kelly, Mom Crawford and Mom Campbell. Our summer workers came from Ada S. McKinnley and others.

So much can be said about Love, Faith and Hope but for the sake of time know that we are a Lutheran Community Church. We are still moving *FULL SPEED AHEAD*.
